

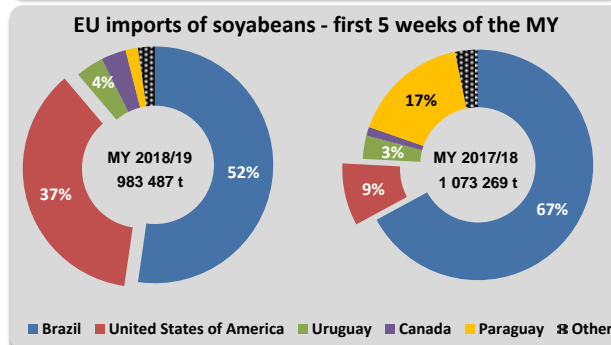
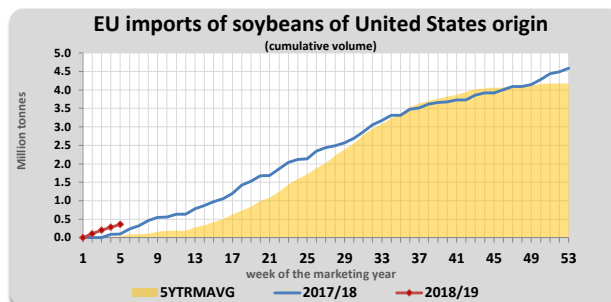
## Focus on EU soyabean and soyameal imports from US provisional data for the first 5 weeks of the marketing year (update on 30 July 2018)

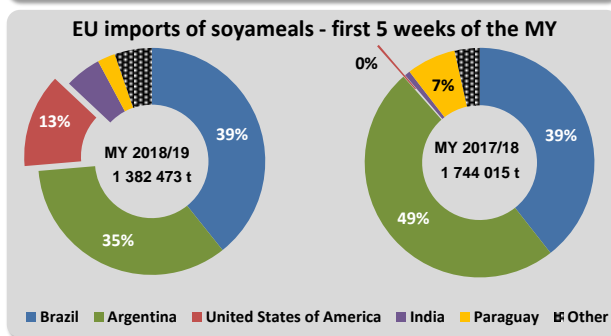
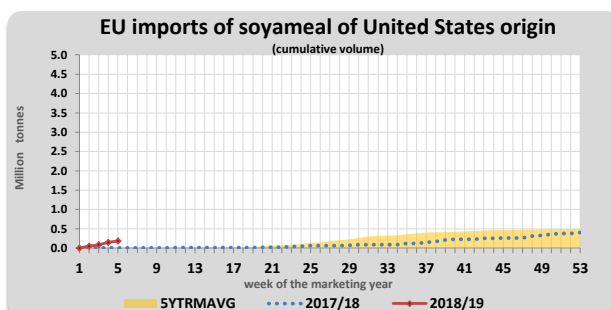

### Summary:

For July, the beginning of the marketing year for soyabeans we have a substantial increase in imports from US.  
US prices for both soyabeans and soyameal are currently the most competitive on the market.

### Technical notes:

- Marketing year (MY) from 1 July to 30 June
- Provisional trade data based on notified customs declaration through the TAXUD Surveillance system. Data for the 2018/19 MY are expected to be revised upwards after receiving the final notifications from the customs authorities.
- The weekly reference period is from Monday to Sunday (starting from 1 July)
- The first 5 week of the MY: for the 2018/19 MY from 1/07/2018 to 29/07/2018; for the 2017/18 MY from 1/07/2017 to 30/07/2017
